Medbio is pleased to announce the delivery of our 22nd press on January 18th. Our latest addition is a new Arburg 470C-165 ton hydraulic molding press with a 5oz shot size. This new machine will add both redundancy and additional capacity to our molding capabilities, and will be used for some of our higher volume work.

Like most of our Arburg machines, this press has cavity-pressure sensing capabilities, using Kistler-brand sensors. This machine is also equipped with a hydraulic core pull and pneumatic valve gate control, and will have an automated packaging cell.

The new machine will be operational by January 27th, with the automation equipment scheduled to arrive at the end of February.
